2015 Dec. 14 Monday Message 9 From P.75 row 1 to P.77 row 24	1 John 1:5 5 And this is the message which we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. John 1:4 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.
2015 Dec. 15 Tuesday Message 9 From P.77 row 25 to P.79 row 6	1 John 1:6 6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and are not practicing the truth; John 8:12 12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to them, saying, I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall by no means walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
