2015 Apr 20 Monday Message 1 From P.1 to P. 3	Gal 1:1-2 1 Paul, an apostle (not from men nor through man but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised Him from the dead), 2 And all the brothers who are with me, to the churches of Galatia:
2015 Apr 21 Tuesday Message 1 From P.4 to P. 7	Gal 1:3-4 3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, 4 Who gave Himself for our sins that He might rescue us out of the present evil age according to the will of our God and Father,
2015 Apr 22 Wednesday Message 1 From P.8 to P. 11	Gal 1:5-6 5 To whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen. 6 I marvel that you are so quickly removing from Him who has called you in the grace of Christ to a different gospel,
2015 Apr 23 Thursday Message 2 From P.12 to P. 14	Gal 1:7-8 7 Which is not another gospel, only there are some who trouble you and desire to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But if even we or an angel out of heaven should announce to you a gospel beyond that which we have announced to you, let him be accursed.
2015 Apr 24 Friday Message 2 From P.15 to P. 17	Gal 1:9-10 9 As we have said before, now also I say again, If anyone announces to you a gospel beyond that which you have received, let him be accursed. 10 For am I now trying to win the assent of men or of God? Or am I seeking to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a slave of Christ.
2015 Apr 25 Saturday Message 2 From P.18 to P. 20	Gal 1:11-12 11 For I make known to you, brothers, concerning the gospel announced by me, that it is not according to man. 12 For neither did I receive it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation by Jesus Christ.

2015 Apr 27 Monday Message 3 From P.21 to P. 24	Gal 1:13 13 For you have heard of my manner of life formerly in Judaism, that I persecuted the church of God excessively and ravaged it.
2015 Apr 28 Tuesday Message 3 From P.25 to P. 27	Gal 1:14 14 And I advanced in Judaism beyond many contemporaries in my race, being more abundantly a zealot for the traditions of my fathers.
2015 Apr 29 Wednesday Message 3 From P.28 to P. 31	Gal 1:15 15 But when it pleased God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me through His grace,
2015 Apr 30 Thursday Message 4 From P.33 to P. 35	Gal 1:16 16 To reveal His Son in me that I might announce Him as the gospel among the Gentiles, immediately I did not confer with flesh and blood,
2015 May 1 Friday Message 4 From P.36 to P. 38	2Cor 3:15-16 15 Indeed unto this day, whenever Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart; 16 But whenever their heart turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.
2015 May 2 Saturday Message 4 From P.39 to P. 40	2Cor4:6 6 Because the God who said, Out of darkness light shall shine, is the One who shined in our hearts to illuminate the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2015 May 4 Monday Message 5 From P.41 to P. 43	Gal 1:15 15 But when it pleased God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me through His grace,
2015 May 5 Tuesday Message 5 From P.44 to P. 46	Gal 1:16 16 To reveal His Son in me that I might announce Him as the gospel among the Gentiles, immediately I did not confer with flesh and blood,
2015 May 6 Wednesday Message 5 From P.47 to P. 48	Gal 1:22-24 22 Yet I was still unknown by face to the churches of Judea, which are in Christ. 23 But they only heard this: He who was formerly persecuting us is now announcing as the gospel the faith which formerly he ravaged. 24 And they glorified God because of me.
2015 May 7 Thursday Message 6 From P.49 to P. 52	Gal 2:1-2 1 Then after a period of fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, taking Titus with me also. 2 And I went up according to revelation, and I laid before them the gospel which I proclaim among the Gentiles, but privately to those who were of repute, lest perhaps I should be running, or had run, in vain.
2015 May 8 Friday Message 6 From P.53 to P. 56	Gal 2:3-4 3 But not even Titus, who was with me, though he is a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised; 4 And this, because of the false brothers, brought in secretly, who stole in to spy out our freedom which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into slavery.
2015 May 9 Saturday Message 6 From P.57 to P. 60	Gal 2:5 5 To them we yielded with the subjection demanded not even for an hour, that the truth of the gospel might remain with you.

2015 May 11 Monday Message 7 From P.61 to P. 63	Gal 2:4 4 And this, because of the false brothers, brought in secretly, who stole in to spy out our freedom which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into slavery.
2015 May 12 Tuesday Message 7 From P.64 to P. 65	Gal 3:3 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?
2015 May 13 Wednesday Message 7 From P.66 to P. 67	Gal 5:1 1 It is for freedom that Christ has set us free; stand fast therefore, and do not be entangled with a yoke of slavery again.
2015 May 14 Thursday Message 8 From P.69 to P. 71	Gal 2:16 16 And knowing that a man is not justified out of works of law, but through faith in Jesus Christ, we also have believed into Christ Jesus that we might be justified out of faith in Christ and not out of the works of law, because out of the works of law no flesh will be justified.
2015 May 15 Friday Message 8 From P.72 to P. 74	Gal 3:23-25 23 But before faith came we were guarded under law, being shut up unto the faith which was to be revealed. 24 So then the law has become our child-conductor unto Christ that we might be justified out of faith. 25 But since faith has come, we are no longer under a child-conductor.
2015 May 16 Saturday Message 8 From P.75 to P. 76	Gal 2:19 19 For I through law have died to law that I might live to God.
