**Heb 11:33,39-40**  
33 Who through faith overcame kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, 39 And these all, having obtained a good testimony through their faith, did not obtain the promise, 40 Because God has provided something better for us, so that apart from us they would not be made perfect.
