Message Fifty Six From P.623 row 33 to P.626 row 28 Heb 13:10-12 10 We have an altar from which they who are serving the tabernacle have no right to eat. 11 For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the <i>Holy of Holies</i> for sin by the high priest are burned up outside the camp. 12 Therefore also Jesus, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate.</p>	<p>May. 19 Sat. Message Fifty Six From P.626 row 29 to end of P.629 Heb 13:13-15 13 Let us therefore go forth unto Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach. 14 For we do not have here a remaining city, but we seek after the one to come. 15 Through Him then let us offer up a sacrifice of praise continually to God, that is, the fruit of lips confessing His name.</p>
