12 Beware, brothers, lest perhaps there be in any one of you an evil heart of unbelief in falling away from the living God. 13 But exhort one another each day, as long as it is called "today," lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

Nov. 22 Tue. Message Twenty Five

14 For we have become partners of Christ, if indeed we hold fast the beginning of the assurance firm to the end, 15 While it is said, "Today if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the provocation."

But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry inasmuch as He is also the Mediator of a better covenant, which has been enacted upon better promises.

Dec. 17 Sat. Message Thirty Three
From P.374 row 28 to end of P.379

Heb 7:27-28
27 Who does not have daily need, as the high priests *do*, to offer up sacrifices first for his own sins and then for those of the people; for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself. 28 For the law establishes men as high priests who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which *was* after the law, *establishes* the Son, perfected forever.
